Job Description: Member, Board of Directors

Role: Oversee the operation of Pacific Rim Sculptors – this may include chairing a working committee; participating in fundraising activities and donating as possible to support programs; attending and assisting at events; advocating for the organization and its members. This is a working board; Pacific Rim Sculptors currently does not have paid staff.

Responsibilities and Powers of the Board:

- Establish policies and procedures
- Secure funds for current expenses and for future projects as approved by the Board
- Ensure financial affairs and government reporting requirements are conducted responsibly
- Plan for the future

Specific Duties:

- Attend meetings regularly and on time
- Become well-informed about activities of the organization
- Contribute knowledge and express viewpoints based on expertise and experience
- Listen to viewpoints of others
- Contribute financially to the organization as possible, including paying PRS membership dues
- Assume leadership in fundraising efforts
- Willingly share your network of contacts to help build a strong network for PRS
- Chair or co-chair an active committee
- Represent PRS proudly and positively at events, with other organizations and with private individuals
- Respond in a timely manner to communications from Board members and the general membership
- Avoid conflicts of interest
